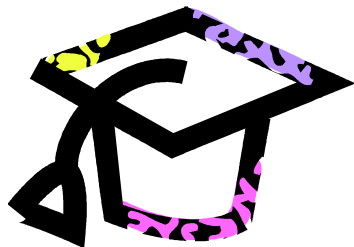



Early Assurance Scholars Program Overview:

The North Carolina Agricultural and Technical State University (NCAT) and East Carolina University - Brody School of Medicine (BSOM) Early Assurance Scholars Program (EASP) provides a unique opportunity for a select group of North Carolina residents at NCAT wishing to pursue a *career in medicine*.

- Each year, NCAT invites outstanding high school seniors to apply for the EASP
- *Students have high GPAs (3.5 or greater) and a combined verbal and math SAT score of at least 1200 (old SAT) or 1270 (new SAT) or ACT of 27. Students with SAT of 1000-1199 (old) or 1080-1260 (new) may also apply. *If selected for the guaranteed seats with lower combined verbal and math scores, scholars must score at least 125 on EACH of the numerically graded sections of the MCAT to be eligible for the guaranteed seat.
- Students demonstrate an outstanding record of participation in academic and extracurricular activities.
- Two of the 78 seats in the BSOM will be reserved (four years in advance) for the top two EASP scholars.

Program Requirements:

- Earn a minimum GPA (both overall and science) of 3.5 by the end of the *senior* year at N.C. A&T
- Complete all medical school requirements by the end of the *junior* year
- Maintain "an acceptable level of personal deportment"

Program Benefits:

- *Top two scholars *will not be required* to take the MCAT for admissions into BSOM if SAT combined V+M equal 1200 or 1270, old and new SAT, respectively, or if ACT score is 27 or higher.
- All participants will complete a 'common curriculum track' and medical school course requirements by the end of the junior year. Scholars will also gain medical and non-medical related experience while in the program.
- At the completion of the program, *ALL* participants will be well prepared to enter medical school
